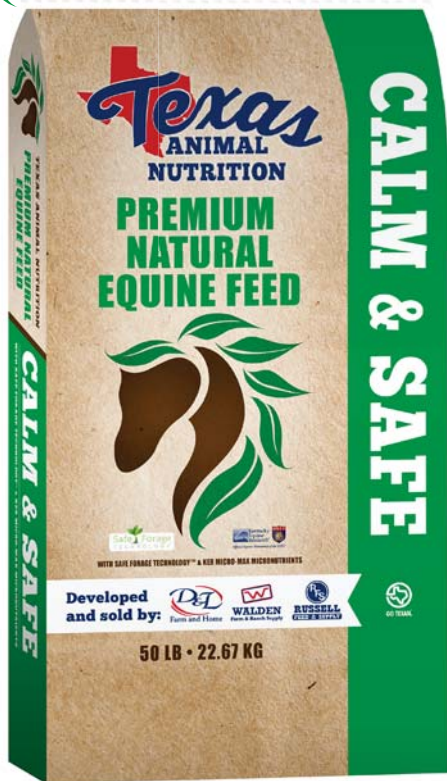

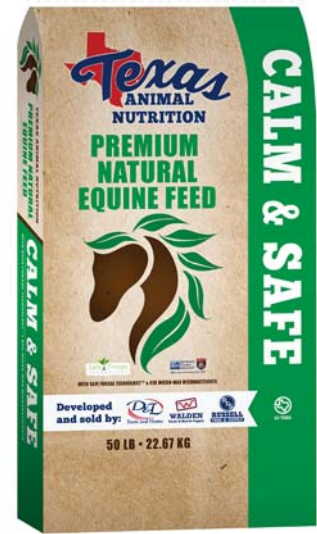

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Begin feeding the amounts given in the chart below based on the horse's weight. Horses should be routinely evaluated for appropriate body condition; the feeding amount may be increased or decreased to obtain desired weight and body condition. For more specific nutrition program options, visit TexasAnimalNutrition.com and utilize the MicroSteed™ Ration Wizard to create a feeding protocol tailored to your horse, or contact your Texas Animal Nutrition Feed representative for assistance. Provide free-choice access to fresh water and salt. Limit meal size to 0.5 lb per 100 lb of body weight per meal. Consult with your veterinarian for more information about total health care for your horse.

FEEDING GROWING HORSES OVER 6 MONTHS OF AGE:

May be used with growing horses older than 6 months of age. Feed a minimum of 1% of body weight of high quality forage per day combined with 1 to 1.5% of body weight of Calm & Safe. Contact your Texas Animal Nutrition representative for specific diets for growing horses.
