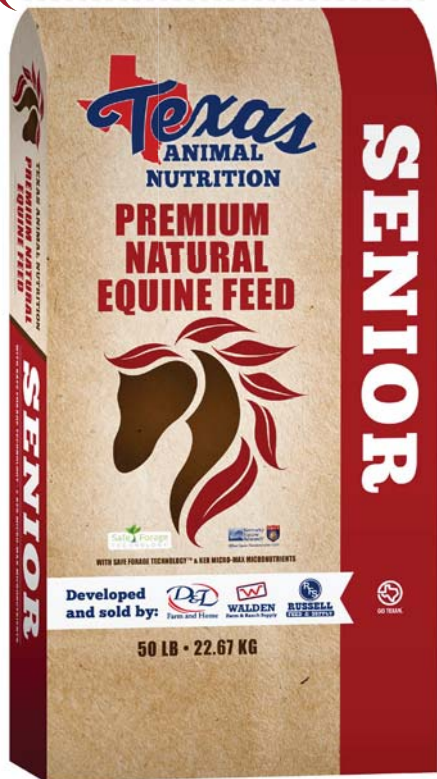

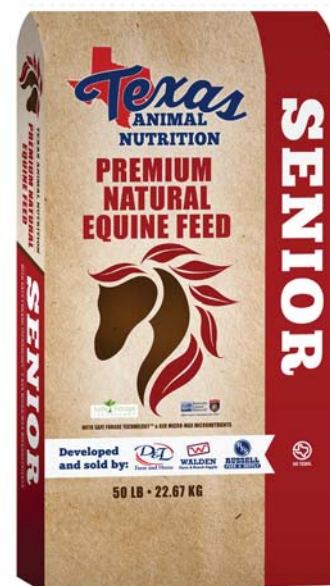

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Begin feeding the amounts given in the chart below based on the horse's weight. Horses should be routinely evaluated for appropriate body condition; the feeding amount may be increased or decreased to obtain desired weight and body condition. Provide free-choice access to fresh water and salt. Limit meal size to 0.5 lb per 100 lb of body weight per meal.
